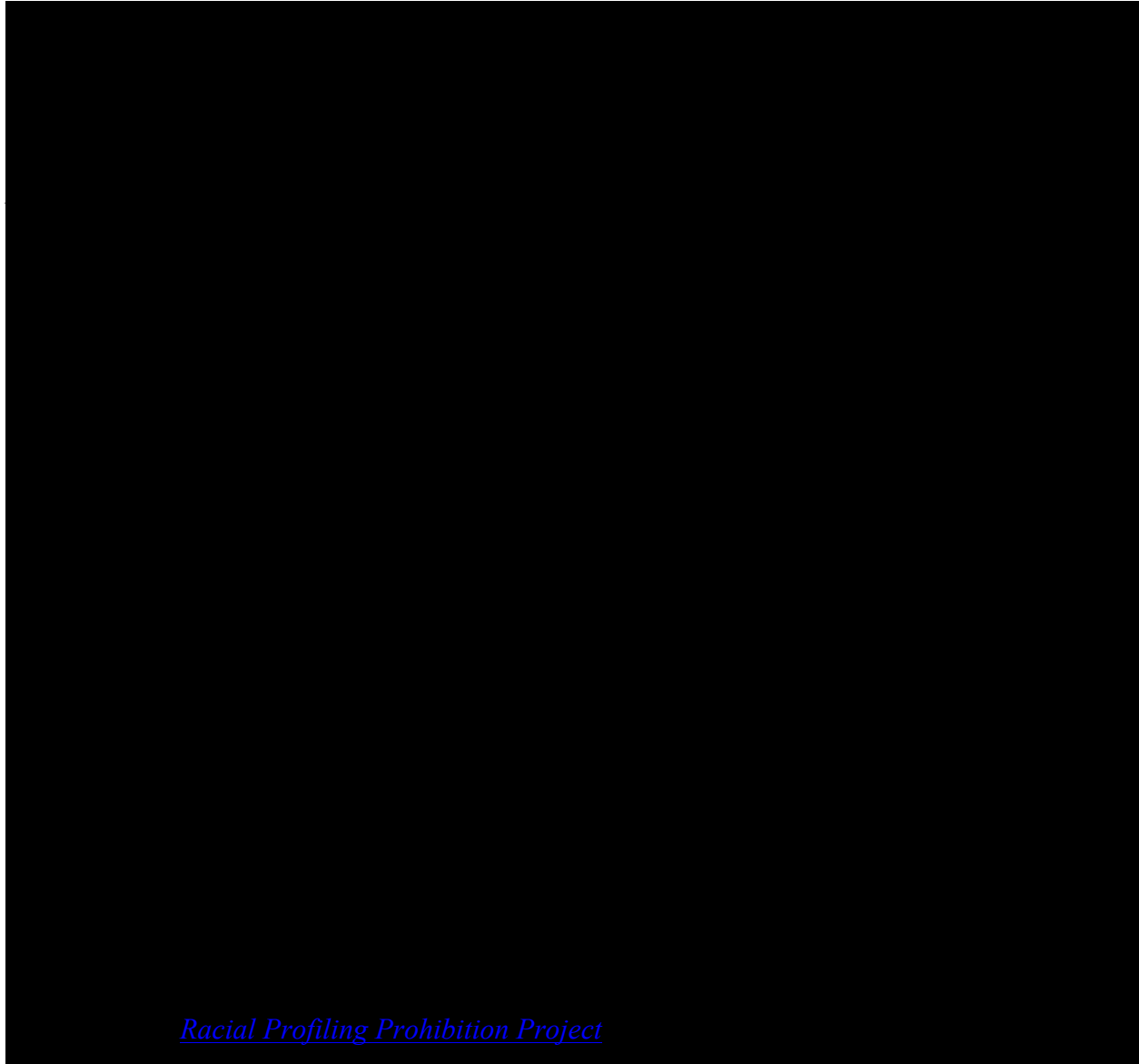

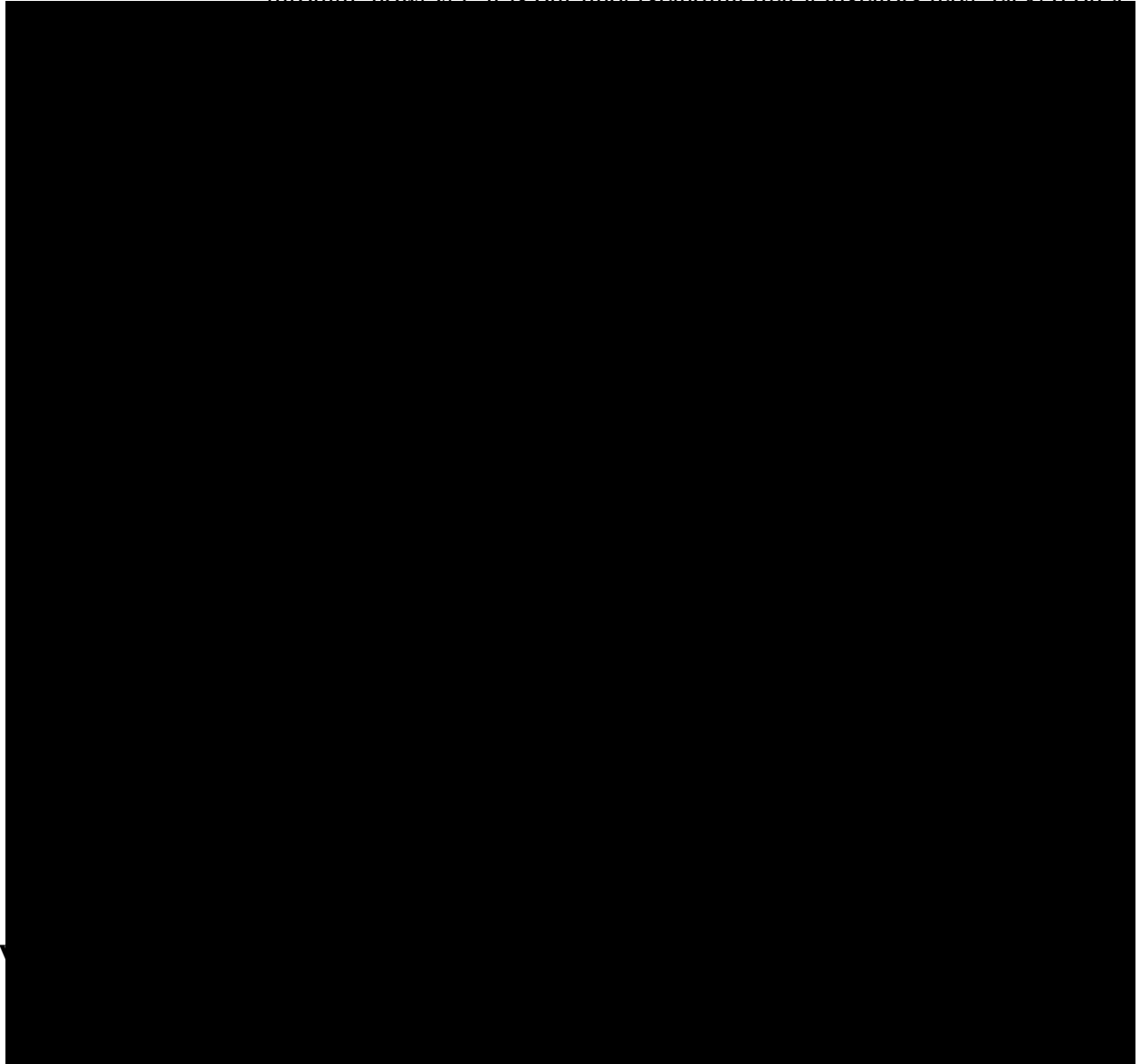
Racial Profiling Prohibition Project
